Poultry Keeping skills for leaners with deafblindness

Poultry keeping prepares learners to engage in income-generating activities. The learner will be equipped with poultry keeping skills such as measuring feeds, watering, maintaining cleanliness, collecting eggs, selling, keeping records, etc. in order to prepare him/her earn a living and live an independent life.

Interventions;

- Providing materials and tools to the learner
- Guiding the learner in identifying poultry
- Supporting the learner to orient self to the poultry area
- Guiding the learner to carry out poultry keeping activities
- Demonstrating various poultry keeping activities
- Guiding the learner to clean the poultry house
- Supporting the learner to collect, store and sell poultry products
- Guiding the learner in keeping poultry records
- Reinforcing learner's positive behaviour
- Recording achievements and progress
- Contacting veterinary doctors

Achievement Indicators

The learner can

- participate in poultry keeping activities such as feeding birds, cleaning poultry area, collecting eggs, etc.
- improve income levels.

Resources/Materials

Real birds, trays, feeding troughs/feeders, drinkers, ropes, water, wheelbarrow, spade, sacks, object of reference, calendar system, gumboots, poultry shade, poultry feeds, sprayers, acaricides, etc.
